About the competition



Green Future: Ecological Female Projects Award by the Council of the Eurasian Women's Forum is the first international competition of women's projects in the field of ecology and sustainable development from BRICS countries, organized by the Council of the Eurasian Women's Forum under the Federation Council of the Federal Assembly of the Russian Federation and Rosatom State Corporation, aims to popularize women's initiatives in ecology, encourage women's social activity, and promote and replicate the best environmental projects across BRICS nations.



The competition is being held for the first time as part of the implementation of the Fourth Eurasian Women's Forum action plan.

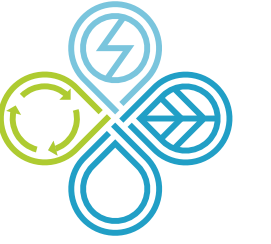

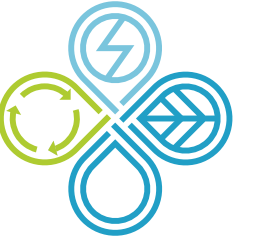
The nomination is dedicated to innovative achievements that contribute to environmental protection through science and technology.

The nomination invites women leaders developing public initiatives that promote environmental awareness and eco friendly behavior in society.

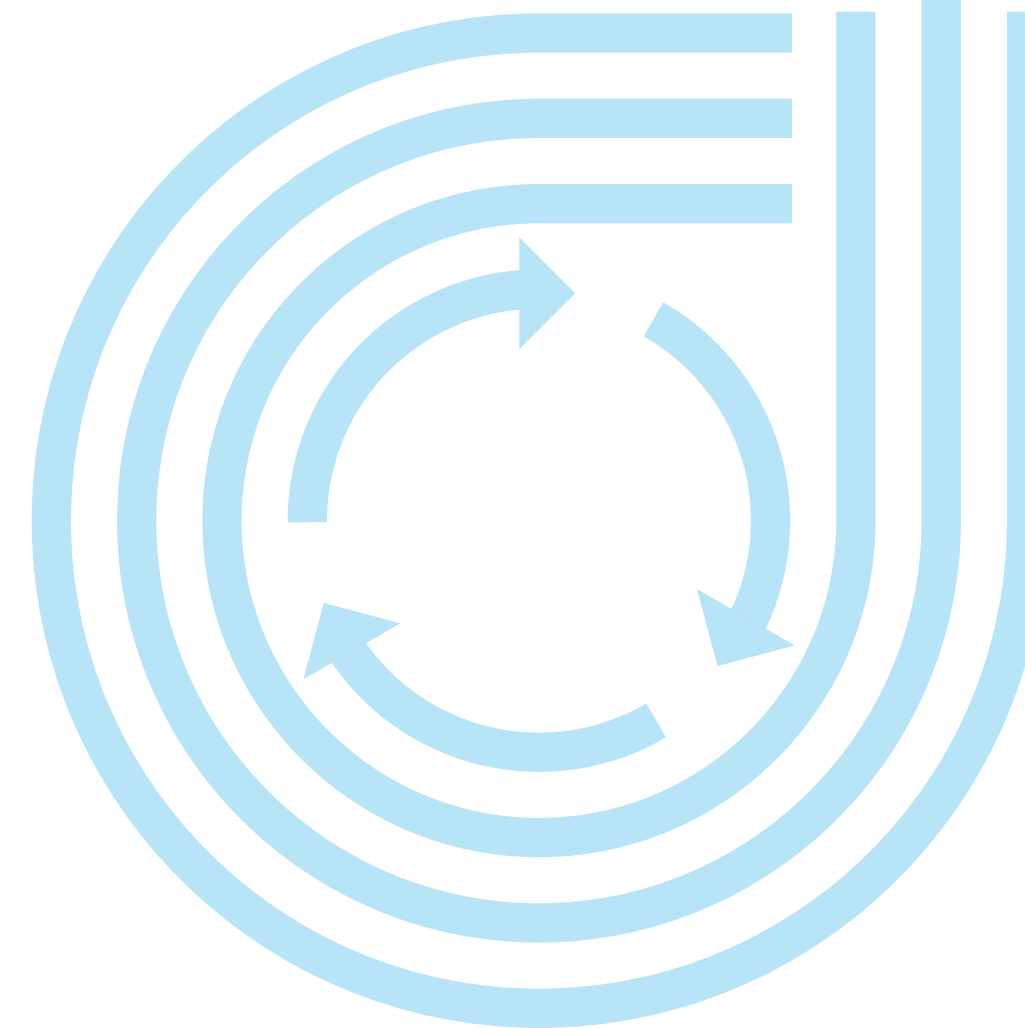
Green Corporation

The nomination focuses on women leaders who are successfully running environmental projects in large industrial companies and in eco-oriented businesses.

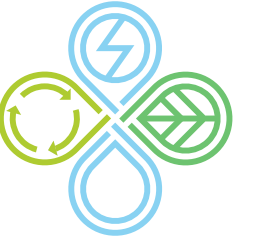


Who can participate

- ✓ Women from BRICS member countries — Brazil, Russia, India, China, South Africa, Iran, Egypt, Ethiopia, the United Arab Emirates, and Saudi Arabia — are invited to participate, regardless of their place of residence.
- ✓ A participant in the competition can only be a woman who is a representative of an organization, a direct manager, a leader of a business initiative within a corporation, the head of her own environmental project, or an activist, influencer, or educator in the field of ecology and sustainable development.
- ✓ The participant must have at least 3 years of verified experience in ecology and be involved in implementing environmental projects in BRICS member countries.



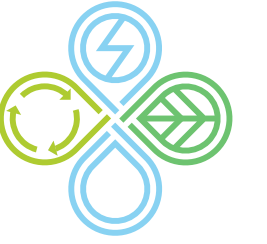
Project requirements

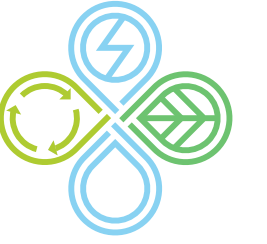


- ✓ The project or initiative should aim to improve environmental conditions, contribute to sustainable economic and business development, and raise public awareness about ecology.
- ✓ The project or initiative must be led by a woman who is a citizen of one of the BRICS member countries.
- ✓ The project or initiative can be implemented in any BRICS country, not necessarily in the participant's country of citizenship.
- ✓ The project or initiative must have already been implemented by the time of application and show verified results. All information about the project and/or initiative must be accurate.

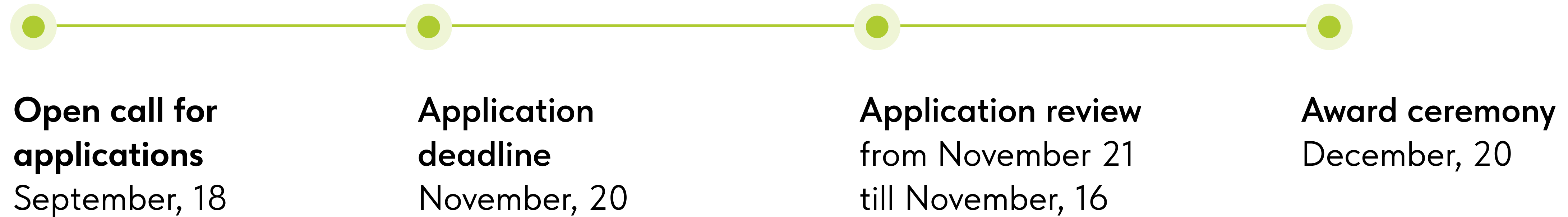
Benefits for participants

- ✓ The opportunity to present the project internationally.
- ✓ Mentoring support from international experts for finalists and winners.
- ✓ Interviews with winners and finalists with international media.
- ✓ An official certificate issued by the Council of the Eurasian Women's Forum and Rosatom.
- ✓ Winner's diploma. The printed winner's diploma is presented at the official event in Moscow or mailed upon request.
- ✓ An opportunity to become part of an international women's environmental community that brings together activists from BRICS countries.
- ✓ An opportunity to engage participants from BRICS countries in your project.
